



Annual Local Park Pass Information Sheet

What is an Annual Local Park Pass?

The Annual Local Park Pass provides unlimited entry for local residents or ratepayers to one park or a group of local parks for twelve months.

How much does the Annual Local Park Pass cost?

The Annual Local Park Pass costs \$23.00 and can be used to enter a park in a vehicle with up to twelve legally seated people.

Who is eligible to purchase an Annual Local Pass?

The Annual Local Park Pass is available to residents or ratepayers in specified local government areas adjacent to a park or group of parks. People can simply show basic identification when purchasing the pass to demonstrate that they are a local resident or ratepayer.

Which Annual Local Park Pass can I buy?

Annual Local Park Passes for the parks and groups of parks listed in the table on the back of this page are available to residents and ratepayers of the corresponding local government areas. One park or group of parks per Annual Local Park Pass.

What is the advantage of the Annual Local Park Pass?

The pass is available specifically for local residents that visit their local parks regularly. It also recognises contributions made by local governments for the provision of visitor infrastructure, such as access roads to parks.

What is the best value for me on holidays?

Several options are available for visitors on holiday.

- Visitors to any of the parks at which fees currently apply can pay a day entry fee. This fee covers visits to more than one park on the same day.
 - A day entry pass costs \$13 per vehicle.
 - Holders of eligible concession cards may pay the concession fee of only \$7 per vehicle.
 - Motor cycle riders need only pay \$7.
 - If camping, a day entry fee is only payable on the first day even if intending to camp for one or two weeks continuously.
 - Free entry applies to visitors who walk or cycle into a park.
- An Annual Local Park Pass can be used at any time when the holder visits the park or group of parks to which the pass applies.
- Extended passes are also available:
 - A Holiday Pass, at \$46, allows unlimited entry to all parks in WA for four weeks.
 - An Annual All Parks Pass, at \$92, provides unlimited entry to all parks in WA for 12 months and represents extremely good value for money.
 - Holders of eligible concession cards may purchase a Concession Annual All Parks Pass for only \$58.
