

NATIONAL PARKS AND RESERVES

Effective from 12:01am 29 June 2021 until 12:01am Saturday, 3 July 2021, the Perth metropolitan area and Peel region will enter a lockdown.

All national and regional park day-use sites, campgrounds and playgrounds in the lockdown area will be closed during this time.



Campers are encouraged to leave campgrounds as soon as possible and make other arrangements.

Staff are requested to be considerate of those camping who have no fixed address or from interstate or who are unable to return home or cannot find alternative accommodation.

Visitors are encouraged to follow official State Government restrictions for their own safety. Members of the public are reminded that this is an evolving situation and travel, site-specific and other restrictions may be further introduced at short notice.

People who live within 5km of a national or regional park within the lockdown area can still use these areas to exercise. Maximum of two adults at a time from the same household (children under 18 years are not counted), limited to one hour per day, and masks must be worn, except for vigorous exercise.

If you are in the Perth or Peel region and were planning to travel to other regions during the lockdown period, you will need to delay your departure, unless travelling for essential purposes. Campground booking fees will be refunded to affected customers, who will be contacted by email. You are not required to cancel your booking or contact us. We will be in touch with you shortly. We appreciate your patience as we work through the refund process.

This closure includes all attractions, including visitor centres etc within the lockdown area.
